Programme Plan of

School-based After-school Learning and Support Programmes 2023-2024

Objective

In the past 44 years, our school has been exerting efforts to provide whole-person education to our students catering to their moral, intellectual, physical, social, aesthetic and spiritual development. Specifically in this programme, we wish to achieve the above aim through activities in Orchestra, Chinese Orchestra, Spring Camp, Graduation Camp and Training Camps, together with other enrichment activities. A number of students, including those CSSA and full grant SFA recipients (about 20% of our student body), might have difficulties in paying the fees required and thus missing the benefits from these activities. So this school-based grant would help those students to pay the necessary fees. Half grant recipients will be subsidized with half payment by this grant.

Details

- 1. **Orchestra** after school and/or weekends for the whole school year; number of target students served estimated to be 10; school will employ music tutors for the training classes.
- 2. **Chinese Orchestra** after school and/or weekends for the whole school year; number of target students served estimated to be 10; school will employ music tutors for the training classes.
- 3. **Spring Camp** 4 days in Easter Holidays; expected number of participants is 250; number of target students served will be about 25 (10% of 250); teachers and the camp staff will organize all the activities.
- 4. **Graduation Camp** 4 days in June after public examinations; expected number of participants is 80; number of target students served will be about 5 (6% of 80); teachers and the camp staff will organize all the activities.
- 5. **Training Camp** camp arranged for prefects, student librarians and student counsellors; expected number of participants is about 120; number of target students served will be about 10 (8% of 120); teachers and the camp staff will organize all the activities.
- 6. **Enrichment Activities** All students are required to join House Picnic. Students are also encouraged to participate in competitions/programmes/trips introduced by teachers; number of target students served will be about 75 [10% of 742 (F.1 F.6)].
